About Islamic Help's Water and Sanitation Programme

Islamic Help provides clean drinking water to residents of areas considered most in need. One of the ways to provide residents with access to water is by digging wells, water pumps and installing water plants. Since 2006 Islamic Help has installed over 20,000 water hand pumps, over 1000 wells, 1 water filtration plant and 3 water filtration stations across many different countries.

Recently, our projects have been concentrated in Pakistan, Bangladesh, Cameroon, Tanzania, Gaza and Yemen, and we are currently installing solar powered water stations in Rohingya camps.

Global Water Issues

Access to safe drinking water and improved sanitation is fundamental for health, income generation, poverty alleviation, human rights and personal dignity. Providing access to safe water is one of the most effective instruments in promoting health and reducing poverty. There are around 2.4 billion people across the world who do not have access to sanitation facilities and 663 million who do not have access to clean and safe water sources.

According to the United Nations and UNICEF, one in five girls of primary school age are not in school, compared with one in six boys. Girls are more likely to be responsible for collecting water for their family, making it difficult for them to attend school during school hours.

Field Notes

Following a careful field survey and analysis, Islamic Help's country office deemed it necessary to construct a water source to serve the locals in the surrounding area with your generous donations and support. The source would provide water for drinking, cooking and other uses.

The beneficiaries are delighted with the water source. They no longer need to go to other households or villages to fetch water and girls who left education to assist their mothers in collecting water are now free to be educated. May Allah reward you for this great act of support.

Sustainability

A meeting was held with the beneficiaries to include the community in sustaining the water source. A village committee was then created, comprising of the local government representative and the head of the beneficiaries' family. This committee will maintain the project by collecting a very small amount of money from the beneficiaries.

Islamic Help's country office will review the project every three months to ensure it is functioning appropriately. In a case where the committee fails to repair the water source and they inform the country office, they will immediately take the initiative to keep the source functioning.
